

The Truth About Jesus

Through three distinct time frames

The key that unlocks the door to understanding Jesus.

John 16:28

"I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world; again, I leave the world, and go to the Father." (KJV)

I. His Origin

His Past

"I came forth from the Father."

Consider: John 1:1; Philippians 2:6; John 6:38, 13:3

The discussion of the doctrine of the trinity is NOT about the time frame prior to birth

III. His Destiny

His Future

"I... go to the Father"

I Corinthians 15:27-28; Romans 1:3,4; Hebrews 8:6; Hebrews 1:3

The discussion of the trinity is NOT about the time frame following His resurrection.
The man-made doctrine of the trinity has NO foundation in Scripture.

II. His Mission

His Present

"...and am come into the world"

The discussion about the trinity IS concerning this time frame (John 3:16; Philippians 2:7; John 17:3)

"In the days of His flesh" (Hebrews 5:7)

No reference to Jesus being God in this time frame

As One of Us

From Hebrews:

He **accomplished** as a MAN:

1. The adequate sacrifice for all sin. (Hebrews 2:6-9)
 2. He enabled us to be as he was: A brother of the sanctified. (Hebrews 2:14).
 3. He rendered Satan powerless. (Hebrews 2:14).
 4. He acquired perfection. (Hebrews 2:9, 10)
 5. He became qualified as our High Priest. (Hebrews 2:16, 17, 18; 4:15; 5:10).
 6. He learned obedience. He provided salvation. (Hebrews 5:8, 9).
 7. He became the example of a normal man (Hebrews 4:14-16; Peter 2:21).
- What else could there be for Him to accomplish as a man? There just isn't anything left. He did it all as a man!
- He came in a nature capable of sinning. Otherwise the recorded temptations have NO value to us. (Hebrews 2:16; James 1:13)

From Gospel of John:

He was **enabled** like an **Apostle** (Hebrews 3:1; 2:1-4)

1. All things provided to Jesus (John 3:35).
 2. His works and miracles were given to Jesus from the Father (John 5:36).
 3. Jesus was subject to the Father. (John 4:34; 5:30).
 4. His Word and Teachings came from the Father. (John 7:16-18; 12:50)
 5. Even His disciples were given to Him (John 18:9).
 6. All judgment was given to Him from the Father. (John 5:22, 27).
 7. Even His Name was given to Him (John 17:11 NASB).
- If while He was here "In the days of His flesh" He were God, Why was He aided in the same way as the apostles?
- John 1:18, "No man has seen God at any time."

Acts 2:22

"...Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know..."
