

# Who is this Jesus?

(SCRIPTURES SUPPLEMENT)

## Part 1

### ***Jesus was not ashamed to become a man:***

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Phil 2:5-9

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, **6** who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, **7** but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. **8** Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. **9** For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name

## The teachings of the book of Hebrews:

### ***The matter of Dying:***

Heb 2:9

But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, *namely*, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.

Isa 59:1-4

Behold, the LORD'S hand is not so short  
That it cannot save;  
Nor is His ear so dull  
That it cannot hear.

**2** But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God,  
And your sins have hidden *His* face from you so that He does not hear.

**3** For your hands are defiled with blood  
And your fingers with iniquity;  
Your lips have spoken falsehood,  
Your tongue mutters wickedness.

**4** No one sues righteously and no one pleads honestly.  
They trust in confusion and speak lies;  
They conceive mischief and bring forth iniquity.

Therefore the chief priests and the Pharisees convened a council, and were saying, "What are we doing? For this man is performing many signs. **48** "If we let Him *go on* like this, all men will believe in Him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place and our nation." **49** But one of them, Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all, **50** nor do you take into account that it is expedient for you that one man die for the people, and that the whole nation not perish." **51** Now he did not say this on his own initiative, but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus was going to die for the nation, **52** and not for the nation only, but in order that He might also gather together into one the children of God who are scattered abroad. **53** So from that day on they planned together to kill Him.

## ***The matter of Equality***

Heb 2:6, 7, 9

But one has testified somewhere, saying,  
"WHAT IS MAN, THAT YOU REMEMBER HIM?  
OR THE SON OF MAN, THAT YOU ARE CONCERNED ABOUT HIM?  
**7** "YOU HAVE MADE HIM FOR A LITTLE WHILE LOWER THAN THE ANGELS;  
YOU HAVE CROWNED HIM WITH GLORY AND HONOR,  
AND HAVE APPOINTED HIM OVER THE WORKS OF YOUR HANDS;

**9** But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, *namely*, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.  
Heb 2:11
